Please assist us by meeting any deadlines with requests for information e.g site plans, activity forms – this will ensure that your site/activity will work in the best possible way, with what is being planned around you.

Keep in mind that there will be thousands of community members attending, all with different levels of awareness – please work with us to ensure your set up is safe.

In 2020 we are banning the use of plastic straws to commence our committment to reducing the impact our festival has on the environment, and ask that cans or biodegradable materials are to be used instead of plastics. We also require you to be responsible in the disposal of your own rubbish.

If engaged to be part of the Fringe, you will be asked to provide relevant compliance information (eg FBN, RSA, Insurance)

Once engaged you'll be provided with our marketing material and will be expected to make use of them for any promotion of your involvement, for consistent branding of the festival.

When dressing your venue/site/van/stall think Fringe! Coloured lights, chalk boards, wear a hat, grab a costume! Our 2020 theme is Retro Futuristic and we encourage neon colours.
